It is **always** a good idea to let the trip leader know you plan to attend. **For overnight events, please advise the trip leader well in advance of the departure date.**

Club policy states no dogs are allowed on Angora Hiking Club hikes/walks.

Recommended per person round-trip fee to be paid the driver in cases of car pooling: \$1.00 <25 miles; \$2.50 <50 miles; \$5.00 <100 miles; \$10.00 > 100 miles Car-pooling is highly encouraged.

**Annual Dues** are \$7.00 per calendar year, preferably paid by February 15 each year. Requirements for membership are: 1) completion of one significant hike with the Angora Hiking Club, (Saddle Mountain, Angora Peak, Neahkahnie Mountain, etc.) and 2) two additional walks/hikes/events with the club, completion of a membership application, 3) next a vote by the current members at the next quarterly meeting and 4) payment of dues. **A person is not required to be a member to hike with the club.**

On all hikes, participants need to stay together, follow the leader and stay ahead of the appointed rear guard (or sweep). There should always be a rear guard or sweep. If hikers opt to go off on their own, they must notify the rear guard/sweep so the rest of the hikers are not waiting for them. Hikers should evaluate their own hiking ability so they do not slow up other hikers. Volkswalks are 10K or 6.2 mile hikes and are marked M/D or D because of the distance & elevation.
